COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

The RAWK Starts Here

Skill level required: No previous lessons required just a strong attitude.

The goal for these kids is to grab onto the love of music and learn how to have fun performing with other musicians. The camp for beginning rockers will include group lessons on individual instruments: guitars, drums, bass, keyboards, and vocals.
